BOARD, TECHNICAL COMMITTEE and WORKING GROUPS (WG)

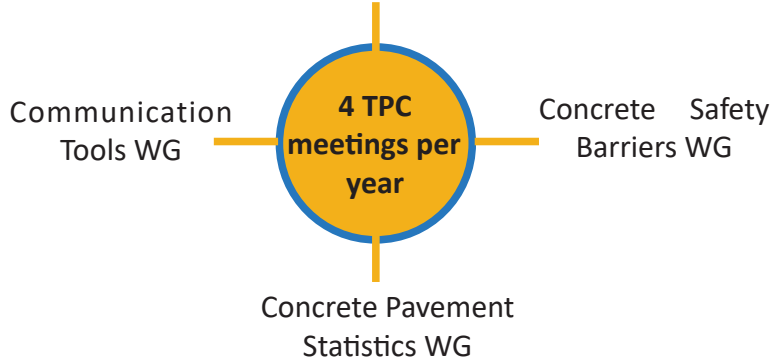
The Technical and Promotion Committee (TPC) ensure the evolution of the Association and serves as an advisory body for the decisions to be taken by the Board of Directors. The Board and TPC meetings follow the development of the work done by EUPAVE's WGs (see more detail below).

A General Assembly is held at least once a year where all Members of the Association have the right to participate and vote. Only Full Members can be elected as Director.

- the **Best Practices WG** to exchange know-how and best practice between industry stakeholders (open to both Members and Partners),
- the **Environmental Strategy WG** to promote the environmental benefits of concrete pavements (open to both Members and Partners),
- the **EU Advocacy WG** to better advocate concrete pavements at EU level (open to Members only),
- the **Concrete Safety Barriers WG** to follow the standardisation activities and to monitor developments on road restraint systems (open to Members only),
- the **Concrete Pavement Statistics WG** to gather data on European concrete roads (open to Members only) and
- the **Communications Tools WG** to develop EUPAVE's website, newsletter and other tools (open to Members only).

For each WG conference calls are held every two months approx.
