

## MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

EUPAVE was founded end 2007 with the objective to study and promote all aspects of cement and concrete contributions to transport infrastructure and paving in general, with particular focus on the specific contributions of concrete products to road safety, fuel consumption, congestion relief and sustainability, amongst others.

On the EUPAVE website [www.eupave.eu](http://www.eupave.eu) you will find detailed information on the different EUPAVE activity areas.

Currently, EUPAVE has 22 members and 16 partners from 15 different countries.

Concerning the EUPAVE structure, our association is a non-profit body under Belgian law. The Board of Directors meets four times a year and the General Assembly meeting is held in the first semester of each calendar year.

Our association consists out of Full Members and Associate Members:



### FULL MEMBERS

are national and international associations, companies, federations or natural persons of whom the activity relates directly or indirectly to the European cement and concrete industry and the transport infrastructure in general.

They yearly pay the Full Membership fee of **8 000,00 EUR** and are entitled to a list of rights, including the possibility to be elected as a Director in the Board of Directors and reduced fees for seminars, conferences, worksite visits, etc.

### ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

are national and international associations, companies, federations or natural persons of whom the activity relates directly or indirectly to the European cement and concrete industry and the transport infrastructure in general.

They yearly pay the Associate Membership fee of **3 700, 00 EUR** and are entitled to a list of rights, including representation in the different EUPAVE Committee Meetings. They cannot delegate a Director to the Board of Directors and their advantages, like reduced fees for seminars, conferences, worksite visits etc., are lower than those applicable for Full Membership.

## MEETINGS, COMMITTEES and WORKING GROUPS

- The General Assembly is composed of all members (Full and Associate) of the association.

All members may have themselves represented by one or more representatives, member or not. All members, Full and Associate, have voting right in the General Assembly.

Associate Members have only voting right regarding the nomination of the directors.

An Associate Member can in any case support the candidacy of a Full Member or propose a candidate among the Full Members, but cannot be elected as Director or apply for candidacy.

- The Technical and Promotion Committee (TPC) ensures the evolution of the association and serve as an advisory body for the decisions to be taken by the Board of Directors.

Participants in these committee meetings are EUPAVE members, who meet four times a year in Brussels. Full and Associate members are represented in one of these committees.

In addition to the TPC, the EU Advocacy Working Group (WG), Best Practices WG, Concrete Safety Barriers WG and Communications Tools WG are the bodies where the members focus on respective issues and discuss on specific actions. They held conference calls every two months.

- Access to the EUPAVE extranet will allow you, as EUPAVE member, to follow the latest information on the Board and Committee meetings, the budget, annual report, events, etc.
